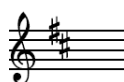

Lullaby – A lullaby is a piece of music that is sung or played to put babies to sleep. This is no.4 from a set of 5 songs by Brahms.

Andante – to be played at an easy walking pace. $\text{♩} = 69-72$ indicates a beat of 69-72 crotchets per minute

Key – D major

Key Signature -  2 sharps , which are F# and C#

Time Signature -  Simple Triple , 3 crotchets per bar

Notes used – Minims  , Dotted Crotchets  , Crotchets  , Quavers 

Rests used –  Whole Bar or Semibreve rest ,  Crotchet rest ,  Quaver rest

Signs and Terms used - *mf* Mezzo Forte – Moderately Loud

f Forte – Loud

p Piano – soft

 Cresc. – Crescendo – gradually getting louder

 Dim. – Diminuendo – gradually getting softer

 - Slur – play the notes in one bow to make a legato sound – smoothly



grace note - a kind of music notation used to denote several kinds of musical ornaments. normally indicates the intention of an acciaccatura
